The book - *naqsh* is an extensive research done over a period of 4 years by Mr. Jay Thakkar; an alumni of S.I.D. Through *naqsh*, the author explores and documents exhaustively in detail the art of wood carving of traditional architecture of Gujarat. Traversing from the history and evolution of wood carving of India, the book investigates thoroughly the tools & techniques applied by the craftsmen working within the trade guilds. The main section comprises of the ornamentations (symbols, motifs and patterns) witnessed on the traditional wooden houses, which are categorized and analyzed in terms of its aesthetics, its occurrence in time and its physical and symbolic relation to the house. The author then establishes its links and connections to the examples found in other cultures and explains the dissemination of this art.

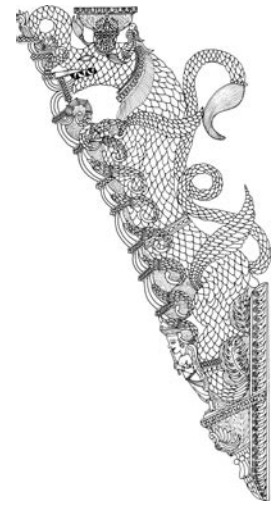

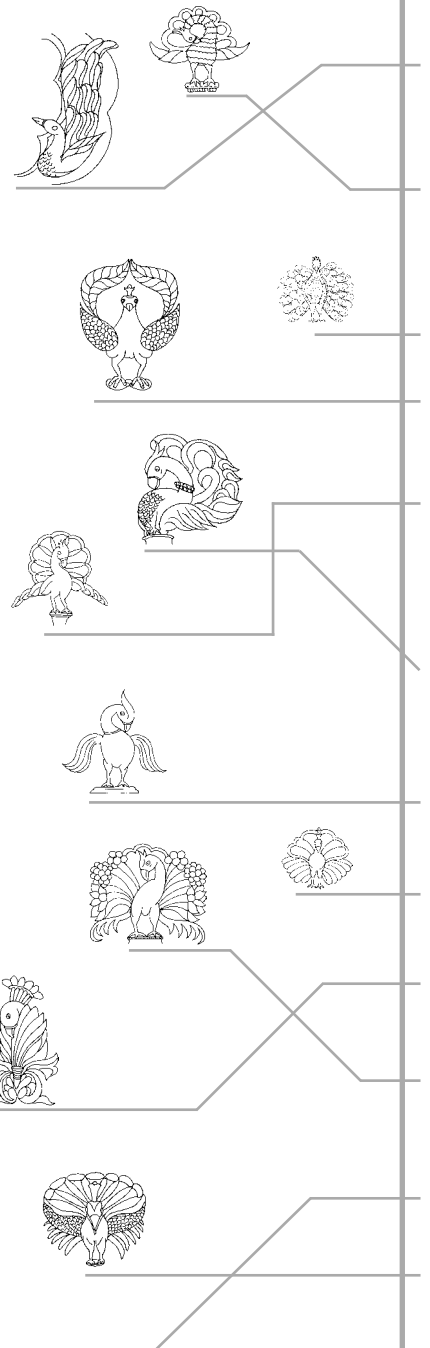
